# At Dramabuds we specialise in providing imaginative drama classes and workshops exclusively for children aged 2-6 years old.

We offer schools, nurseries and early years settings regular weekly classes, one-off themed workshops, after school clubs and end of term drama parties. We support all six areas of Early Years Foundation Stage framework (EYFS) and areas of the Key Stage 1 curriculum. We...



1. Nurture imagination and creativity through drama and imaginary play.

3. Enrich a child's vocabulary and listening skills through interactive storytelling.
4. Promote physical development through dance and movement.

## Regular weekly classes

At each class we go on an exciting interactive story adventure written especially by Dramabuds.

Using drama, movement, imaginative play and song we captivate the children's imaginations. Together we create new worlds, become fun characters and use the children's ideas to solve challenges set within the story.



## After School Clubs

Dramabuds' after school clubs are structured to stimulate young imaginative minds whilst developing concentration and communication skills, encouraging the children's confidence to bloom.

Every week the classes start with lively movement to music. We then do our Dramabuds warm up, dance routines and games, followed by our listen, speak, create and imagine sections of the class. Each term the children work on a new theme and parents are invited to watch the performance at the end of each term.



## Themed Workshops and Parties

## Notes

All classes, workshops and parties take place within your school or nursery setting.

A FREE 30 minute taster class is available (for regular weekly class bookings).

Minimum booking periods are: 1 hour for workshops and parties, 6 weeks for regular weekly classes, 10 weeks for after school clubs.

A class teacher or assistant must be present during the sessions to support the children (except at after school clubs).
